- 5. The schools will close <u>unless/ until</u> it stops snowing soon.
- 6. The job is very urgent, so please do it after/ as soon as you can.
- 7. We'll stay in the library <u>as soon as/until</u> it closes. Then we'll go home.
- 8. Harry will probably learn to drive when/until he's 18.
- 9. You won't be able to speak to the head teacher <u>unless/ if</u> you make an appointment.
- 10. Give Mummy a kiss **before/ after** she goes to work.
