Phishing Texts and emails

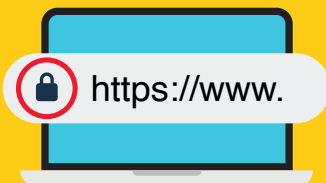
Don't open emails and attachments or click on links if you don't know who sent them.
